

# St Arnaud Rural Women: What our group has been doing over the past 6 months

December 2019 was rather busy, as we did a Christmas display in the Lake Rotoiti Chapel for a week, which was enjoyed by locals and visitors, during that time we had an afternoon with the local ladies on wrapping presents a fun time.

The following week we had a day at the school, making Christmas decoration and wrapping presents with the Junior and Senior children, we were amazed at their clever creations.

2020 started on 2 January with our Annual Book Sale plus Trash "N" Treasure, it was a beautiful day and we had a record number of locals and holiday makers attend. The Book Sale funds plus our catering job done in November went to the everyday running of our group:

- \$20 subsidy to each member for our annual subscription,
- \$1000 to Nelson Marlborough Rescue Helicopter,
- \$1000 to St Arnaud Circuit Breakers for new equipment (exercise group meets three times a week at the Hall),
- \$500 to Lake Rotoiti Yacht Club for learn to sail and maintenance on their boats,
- \$1000 to Rotoiti Outdoor Education Centre for their refurbishment, plus
- emergency packs we give to the local schools (Lake Rotoiti & Tapawera), Hospice, Wakefield Rest home, Local Community Nurse. We continually provide gift baskets for the sick and newborn in our local and surrounding community.

Our "Gumboots Off Day" on 3 March, was a huge success. 71 ladies attended with the hall decorated with gumboots and flowers. They enjoyed a free Ploughman's lunch followed by a Fashion Show from

the lovely ladies at Foggy Town Gifts Murchison, and also Louise Simpson from Tapawera gave demonstrations on massage and make up. Everyone went home with lots of goodies, thanks to Farmlands Richmond, The Town & Country Vets, Allfex, L.I.C, Farm Sources Murchison, Gael Woolf and REAP Marlborough. The reason why we did this special day for women, is that we feel they give so much to the farming community plus their own communities, as it is not often recognised, so nice to have a day off.

The ANZAC parade at our Community Hall, was cancelled due to Convid–19, we have some wonderful plans for 2021.

A small group will head to Owen River Lodge in October, to present 10 "Casting for Recovery" ladies, who have had cancer, with a gift basket, we have done this annually for the past 5 years.

We have made up 6 bags for the Grace Millane/Women's Refuge Project via Richmond Rotary Club.

Our gift of Honey to the permanent residents of the Nelson Lakes area, has been gratefully received, a huge thanks go to Nelson Honey and Rainbow Honey for making this possible.

Calling all New Zealanders - our garden birds need you!

Here's a fantastic reason to be in our gardens, local parks or school grounds and enjoy the peace with our birds.

Get the family involved (or not!) and take part in this year's NZ Garden Bird Survey.

Just select a survey location, and on one day between 27 June and 5 July find a comfortable spot and look and listen for birds for one hour. Record the highest number of each species observed, and submit your results.

The NZ Garden Bird Survey is vital because it tells us about the health of our environment.

The annual survey is the country's longest running citizen science project.

Manaaki Whenua – Landcare Research has led this nationwide initiative since 2007.
