Wasp wipeout - DOC and community wasping, 2023

This year we carried out our annual wasp baiting operation early February (9^a/10^a, with bait collected on 16^a/17^a). It was a massive effort, so a special acknowledgment to everyone who volunteered their time to help out including people from the Friends of Rotoiti, MTB Trails Trust, and Canyoning Aotearoa. Postoperation checks have shown that wasp traffic at 80% of wasp nests monitored in the control area has decreased to undetectable numbers, with remaining nests showing significantly lower traffic than pre operation. Beech honey-dew droplets are already increasing significantly in areas where wasp control occurred.


